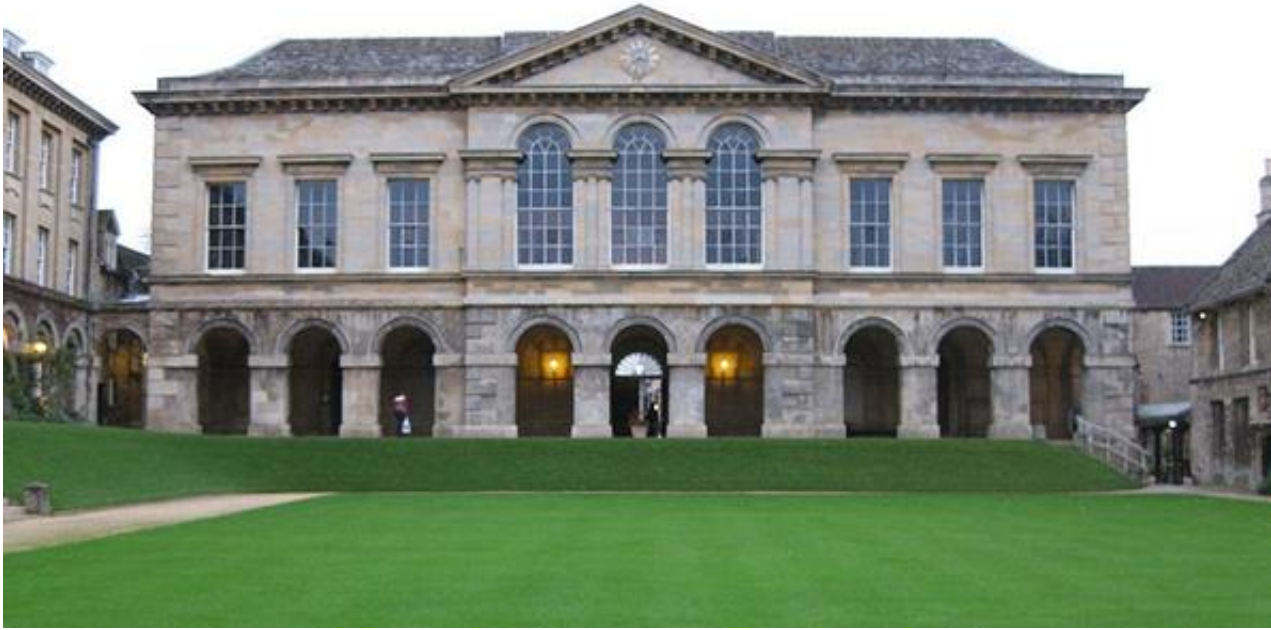




Shortlist unveiled in RIBA's Worcester College Oxford contest

Three practices previously shortlisted for the Stirling Prize have been named among the finalists in the RIBA's Worcester College contest

Dixon Jones, O'Donnell & Tuomey Architects and Rick Mather Architects are joined by 6a Architects, Burd Haward Architects and Wright & Wright Architects in the competition to design a new lecture theatre and kitchen at the Oxford college.

The six teams will now draw up concept designs for the reworked kitchen as well as the 150-seat theatre which will sit within the ground of the listed college and gardens.

Practices will be asked to 'come up with proposals that integrate sensitive, high quality architecture within the truly historic setting'.

The new £3million facilities are set to open in 2014 to coincide with the College's celebration of its 300th anniversary.

The winner of the competition will be announced in June this year (2011).
